<b>RESEARCH PROJECT</b>	<p>The research project which the candidates intend to carry out during their three years of PhD must meet the following requirements: 1) it must indicate a topic consistent with one of the curricula of the PhD (maximum 20.000 characters, spaces included, possible notes and bibliography) and explicitly referring to it; 2) it must include: the state of the art; a description of the project; the expected results; adequate bibliographical references.</p> <p>The research projects that successful applicants shall engage in during their doctoral career may possibly differ from the project proposed at the application stage: this shall be defined together with the supervisor and approved by the Academic Board.</p>																		
<b>INTERVIEW MODE</b>	<p><b>In person</b> (In the application form candidates may ask to conduct the interview remotely)</p> <p>The interview is conducted in Italian language only</p>																		
<b>FURTHER INFORMATION</b>	<p>The interview consists in a discussion on the research project and on other qualification documents and publications (if any), presented by the applicants, and in the assessment of their knowledge of a foreign language (Knowledge of Latin is compulsory for the curriculum in History, Tradition and Textual Criticism of Medieval and Renaissance Texts).</p>
